Where The Lost Things Go is a 'practically perfect' Lent course based on the film *Mary Poppins Returns*. Poet and minister Lucy Berry skilfully draws out some of the themes of the movie and shows how we can consider them more deeply alongside passages from the bible. The sessions aim to explore themes such as belief and unbelief, loss, denial, acceptance and light.
